Insurance Commissioner Praeger promotes health insurance awareness in national radio blitz

TOPEKA, Kan. — Kansas Insurance Commissioner Sandy Praeger stressed the need for being informed about health insurance coverage Tuesday during 18 radio interviews with stations throughout the United States.

The interview sessions were part of an informational package coordinated through the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Commissioner Praeger is the chair of the NAIC's Health and Managed Care Committee and is considered by many in the media as one of the national experts on health insurance.

The Commissioner discussed the need for people to be fully informed about their health insurance policies as they seek flu vaccinations and have other concerns about keeping themselves and their families protected.

She also described efforts and ideas that NAIC has provided in light of national health reform initiatives, and she promoted more educational opportunities for consumers online through the NAIC's www.InsureUonline.org site.
